Editorial

All praise is due to Allah (SWT), and peace & blessing on his noble Messengers (AS), in particular, on the last of them all the blessed Prophet Muhammad (SAW).

The world is sitting on a keg of gunpowder and people are lining up to light a match. In this day and age of ‘breaking news’, 9/11 seems to have occurred ages ago. The West was able to achieve some of its goals in the aftermath of the attacks on the twin towers. Afghanistan was raided and a genuinely evolving Islamic government was overthrown by the ‘coalition of evil’. Next came Iraq, which was attacked and destroyed under the false pretense of ‘weapons of mass destruction’. Lahore (PR): “Pakistan should play the role of a mediator in the conflict between Saudi Arabia and Iran.”

This was stated by the Ameer of Tanzeem e Islami, **Hafiz Aakif Saeed**, during the Khitab e Jumu'ah at Qur'an Academy, Lahore. The Ameer noted that the enemies of Islam wanted to fulfill their nefarious designs by fomenting chaos and anarchy among the Muslim Ummah. He remarked that realities on the ground suggested that the U.S. was an ally of Saudi Arabia, while Iran was being backed by Russia. He said that unity among the Islamic World appeared to be improbable until the Muslim countries did not break themselves free from the shackles of the 'big powers'.

The Ameer stated that the people and the governments of Muslim countries must join hands in order to defeat the plots and schemes made by the enemies against them. While criticizing the negative role played by electronic media, the Ameer said, that they should not play with the emotions of people by conducting heated debates between 'Sunni' and 'Shia' religious scholars, merely for gaining rating points, and avoid adding fuel to fire. He added that such attitude reflected enmity with Islam and could well lead to deterioration of peace and security in Pakistan.

While commenting on the attack on the Pathankot airbase in India, the Ameer said that it was still premature to fix blame as to who was responsible for the incident. He advised the media and the government of India to avoid blaming Pakistan for the incident without any evidence and said that if the government of India did have solid leads and evidence that the plotters of the attack were non-state actors from Pakistan, it should share the information with the Pakistani authorities, so that our state institutions could independently investigate and reach the bottom of the issue.

He concluded by stating that the attack should not be used as a pretext to delay or postpone the Indo-Pak negotiations as it was imperative to build an environment of mutual trust between the two neighboring countries, as soon as possible.

Lahore (PR): “The ruling Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) of India has ONLY changed its modus operandi of dealing with Pakistan, NOT its intentions.”

This was stated by the Ameer of Tanzeem e Islami, Hafiz Aakif Saeed, during the Khitab e Jumu'ah at Qur'an Academy, Lahore. The Ameer noted that the way in which our Prime Minister kept the Foreign Ministry and the National Security Advisor of our country in the dark regarding the recent 'surprise visit' of the Narendra Modi to Pakistan coupled with the fact that Modi's 'meeting' was limited to the 'Sharif Family' only, echoed the style of governance used in a Monarchy rather than a democracy. Moreover, during his visit the Indian PM had done nothing else but display 'great joviality' and 'sheer affection' for PM Nawaz Sharif and family, the Ameer observed.

He remarked that ironically, the National General Secretary of BJP, Ram Madhavan, stated merely a day after Modi's visit that India was now pursuing his party's agenda of Akhand Bharat (a united Pakistan, India and Bangladesh) from a different dimension by using methods of 'affection' and 'warmth in relations' in order to subdue neighboring Pakistan. Ram Madhavan had reportedly added that 'the Berlin Wall of the Indian subcontinent' would inevitably be made to fall in a way similar to Germany. The Ameer stated that it was becoming increasingly clear that India was practically employing its trademark formula of the proverbial 'a sweet tongue, but a hand ready to stab in the back'.

While commenting on the reports about contacts between the Russian and the Afghan Taliban leaderships, the Ameer said that the Muslim Resistance against foreign occupation forces reserved the right to make contact with any legitimate nation for assistance in their efforts to throw the illegitimate occupiers out of their land. He observed that there was no hazard in changing the method of combating occupation forces, so long as the end goal remained constant. He expressed the hope that the Afghan Taliban would eventually succeed in restoring a genuine Islamic Government in Afghanistan by continuing their Jihad for the sake of Allah (SWT) against enemy occupation forces.

He lamented the fact that the government of Pakistan, by continuing a riba-based economy, was engaged in a war with Allah (SWT) and his Messenger (SAW) and thus remained distant from His (SWT) divine support. He concluded by remarking that our country too could attain Allah's (SWT) support, provided that we fulfilled our vows made with Him (SWT) and sincerely strived to make Pakistan a genuine Islamic Nation.

The Whole Truth

Many wonder about the origins of the militant group referred to as the Islamic State of Iraq and Syria (ISIS) a.k.a. ISIL or *Daesh*.

The name ISIS is one that every person on the planet knows. The U.S. State Department says that 'ISIS is the biggest threat to national security since Al-Qaeda. They are a brutal, savage group known for public beheadings and mass executions. They are the face of the new war on terror.'

While the U.S., Britain, Germany and Russia are currently conducting airstrikes in Syria (and France in Iraq too), in a supposed attempt to take out ISIS targets, and the White House & Pentagon are discussing possible boots on the ground, these talks are arising just four years after U.S. President Obama declared that the war in Iraq was over.

Former Defense Secretary Leon Panetta is on record stating that in order to defeat ISIS, he believed the United States was looking at 'a 30-year-war.'

As these 'global powers' go to war in an attempt to defeat yet another terrorist group, the biggest question is: Who exactly is ISIS and where did they come from?

Angela Keaton, the founder of Antiwar.com, says that ISIS is 'entirely a creation of the United States and its bogus war on terror'.

The Italian Foreign Minister said just a few days ago, 'That's how we got to where we are, because of war, because of occupation, because of torture. The United States government completely destabilized and wrecked Iraq. They caused it to fail miserably and that is entirely the fault of the United States government. There is no one else to blame.'

It was not until 2009 that ISIS shifted its focus from Iraq, where it was largely unsuccessful in developing a foothold, to the civil war in Syria. While in Syria, ISIS still struggled to gain a foothold in the beginning. The reason was fairly simple. There were two larger groups fighting against President Bashar al-Assad: The Al-Nusra Front (or Al-Qaeda in Iraq) and The Free Syrian Army (created and funded by the West).

Then came a pivotal moment that most people are not even aware of! In June 2013, a Northern General for the Free Syrian Army spoke out on Al Jazeera Qatar and stated that if international forces did not send weapons, the 'rebels' attempting to overthrow Syrian president Bashar al-Assad would lose their war within a month.

Within a matter of weeks of the Syrian general making his plea for international help, the U.S., the



Saudis, Jordan, Qatar, Turkey and Israel began providing weapons, training and money to the so-called rebel groups. In September 2013, American media outlets began reporting that weapons were being given to 'moderate' Syrian rebels. CNN reported that while the weapons were not 'American-made', they were 'funded and organized by the CIA.'

However, things began to fall apart when less than a year after the U.S. supplied Syrian 'freedom fighters' with weapons, they began ending up in the hands of ISIS fighters; the same ISIS fighters that were being sponsored and funded by the U.S. extreme-right and the likes of Senator John McCain, who had insisted that a more 'brutal set of rebels' was required to overthrow Assad.

It was not until June 2014 that ISIS went from being a no-name group in Syria to a group that was heavily armed and trained by U.S. and Coalition Special Forces. This 'revitalized' group made a dramatic entrance by crossing back over the Syrian border into Iraq and capturing Mosul and much of the northern part of the country.

One of the most important facts that mainstream media ignores time and time again is that ISIS was able to grow so fast because they were provided a free pass to all the U.S. military equipment left in Iraq, including truckloads of Humvees, tanks and other heavy weaponry that instead of taking or destroying, the U.S. government simply decided to leave behind for 'future use'. The ISIS fighters continued to do what the Obama administration wanted, and in late summer 2014, they were labeled as terrorists: 'the new boogeyman in the war on terror.'

But the West and Israel was not going to use their own creation merely as a bogeyman. ISIS was created to achieve much larger goals, such as, defaming Islam to the point that everyone started hated the religion. The atrocities committed by ISIS in the name of 'Islamic Khilafah' such as ethnically cleansing Yazidis, regularly beheading people and, not to forget the attacks in Paris, all served that purpose.

Therefore, it is time that the world wakes-up and rejects the destruction of civilians for the sake of Western foreign policy that makes so-called defense contractors rich, perpetuates violence, spreads death and destroys entire nations, Iraq and Libya being cases in point. This is the central issue of our time – because humanity is greater than politics.

The Yinon Plan and ISIS
